LOCKED CHALKY SLIDE DECK PROMPT

Generate EXACTLY 14 slides total.

This is a hard-locked slide structure.

- Do not generate 13 slides.
- Do not generate 15 slides.
- Do not combine slides.
- Do not compress the outline.
- Do not skip the Standards slide.
- Do not skip Digital Notebook checkpoint slides for any reason.
- Do not replace checkpoint slides with instructional content.
- Do not add quiz, quick-check, true-or-false, multiple-choice, poll, or question slides.
- Count the title slide as Slide 1.

STANDARDS SLIDE RULE

Slide 2 must be a dedicated Lesson Standards slide.

Use the standards information found in the uploaded source documents.

- Include only the first three standards that appear in the uploaded documents.
- If only one or two standards appear, include only those standards.
- If more than three standards appear, omit the additional standards completely.
- Do not paraphrase the standard codes. Keep the codes exactly as written in the uploaded documents.
- Keep each standard concise and readable. Include the standard code and the official standard text when available.
- Do not turn the standards into questions, tasks, checks for understanding, or student prompts.
- The standards slide should be informational only.

Example format for Slide 2:

- Lesson Standards
- 6.SP.3 - Recognize that a measure of center for a numerical data set summarizes all of its values with a single number, while a measure of variation describes how its values vary with a single number.
- 6.SP.5.c - Giving quantitative measures of center and variability, as well as describing patterns and striking deviations in context.

NON-NEGOTIABLE STRUCTURE RULE

Slides 6, 9, and 13 are mandatory blank Digital Notebook checkpoint slides.

- They are required slides in the total count.
- They must always appear even though they contain almost no content.
- They must never be skipped, merged, deleted, replaced, redesigned, or treated as optional.
- They must never become quiz slides, quick-check slides, reflection slides, question slides, or practice slides.

CRITICAL GENERATION RULE

Before generating any slide content, first lock in all 14 slide positions.

- Reserve Slide 2 as the Lesson Standards slide.
- Reserve Slides 6, 9, and 13 as DIGITAL NOTEBOOK slides.
- Then generate the remaining teaching slides around those locked positions.
- Do not reinterpret the three Digital Notebook slides as missing content.
- Do not “helpfully” fill the Digital Notebook slides.
- Do not remove the Digital Notebook slides because they are minimal.
- Do not add any extra question-based slides to make the deck feel interactive.

STRICT DIGITAL NOTEBOOK FORMAT

Slides 6, 9, and 13 must contain ONLY this exact text:

DIGITAL NOTEBOOK

That text must appear in the top right corner only.

These slides must otherwise remain blank.

DO NOT INCLUDE ON SLIDES 6, 9, OR 13

- the word placeholder
- instructions
- questions
- explanations
- labels
- subtitles
- slide numbers
- icons
- graphics
- notebook artwork
- boxes
- borders
- decorative elements
- centered text

- any other text of any kind

If the system normally tries to add design elements, suppress them on Slides 6, 9, and 13.

NO QUESTION-SLIDE RULE

This deck must be instructional only, except for the blank Digital Notebook checkpoint slides.

- Do not generate true-or-false slides.
- Do not generate multiple-choice slides.
- Do not generate quick-check slides.
- Do not generate exit-ticket slides.
- Do not generate quiz slides.
- Do not generate “turn and talk” slides.
- Do not generate discussion question slides.
- Do not generate practice problem slides unless they are part of direct teaching and are not framed as a student-response question slide.
- Do not ask students to answer anything on the Chalky slides.
- The only student-response locations are the blank Digital Notebook slides, which must remain blank except for DIGITAL NOTEBOOK in the top right.

TEACHING FLOW

- Slide 1 = title only
- Slide 2 = standards only
- Slide 3 = introduction / objective
- Slides 4-5 = first teaching chunk
- Slide 6 = blank DIGITAL NOTEBOOK checkpoint
- Slides 7-8 = second teaching chunk
- Slide 9 = blank DIGITAL NOTEBOOK checkpoint
- Slides 10-12 = third teaching chunk
- Slide 13 = blank DIGITAL NOTEBOOK checkpoint
- Slide 14 = closing / summary / positive sign-off

CONTENT RULES

- Keep the lesson within a 30-35 minute block.
- Teach only the essential content.
- Do not add filler.
- Each teaching slide should focus on one clear teachable idea.
- Teaching slides should explain concepts, model thinking, define vocabulary, show examples, or summarize learning.
- Do not include formal student questions or answer choices on teaching slides.

SLIDE-SPECIFIC RULES

- Slide 1 must be the title slide only.
- Slide 2 must be the standards slide only.
- Slide 3 must be the true introduction / objective slide.
- Slide 14 must be the closing slide only.
- Do not introduce new teaching on Slide 14.

INVALID OUTPUT CONDITIONS

The output is invalid if any of the following happen:

- total slide count is not exactly 14
- Slide 2 is missing or is not a dedicated standards slide
- Slide 2 includes more than the first three standards from the uploaded documents
- Slides 6, 9, and 13 do not appear
- Slides 6, 9, and 13 are not reserved as Digital Notebook checkpoint slides
- Slides 6, 9, and 13 contain anything other than DIGITAL NOTEBOOK in the top right
- any teaching content appears on Slides 6, 9, or 13
- any graphics or decorative elements appear on Slides 6, 9, or 13
- any true-or-false, multiple-choice, quick-check, quiz, poll, exit-ticket, or question slide appears anywhere in the deck
- the closing slide is missing
- the title slide is counted incorrectly

FINAL CHECK BEFORE OUTPUT

Silently verify:

- The deck has exactly 14 slides.
- Slide 2 contains the first one to three standards from the uploaded documents and no additional standards.
- Slides 6, 9, and 13 exist.
- Slides 6, 9, and 13 each contain only DIGITAL NOTEBOOK in the top right.
- No teaching content appears on those three Digital Notebook slides.
- No question-based slides appear anywhere in the deck.
- Slide 14 is closing only.

Only after passing all seven checks, generate the deck exactly as specified.
